Coaches meetings will be held one-half hour before competition begins at each

of the seven (7) legs of the conference tournament.

In case of rain, the host coach along with the clubs pro can stop play. Resuming SITES DETAILS:

play requires

club pro and a majority of the conference coaches. If weather cancels a meet, it

is canceled, not rescheduled.

The host school/course will determine which tees will be played. The tees should be similar for both the practice round and the tournament round.

Only varsity matches will be played at the conference tournament sites.

UNIFORM/ EQUIPMENT:

WVC Dress Code: All .schools' players will follow the WVC Dress Code, (11/00)

- Golf slacks or tailored shorts only. NO swimming suits or nylon gym shorts or shorts which go below the knees are permitted. NO jeans. NO short shorts. Belts are required.
- Collared golf shirts or Mock Ts ONLY. (12/09) All shirts must be tucked in all the way around the waist. Garments worn under windshirts, sweatshirts, rain suits, etc., must include collared shirts.
- 3. Hats must be worn with bill forward. Appropriate logos only.
- 4. NO metal spikes.
- 5. NO chains permitted.
- 6. The WVC Dress Code is effect from the time of the team meeting until ALL the final results are recorded.

Penalties for failure to abide by the WVC Dress Code: Ist Offense-Warning; 2nd Offense- Two (2) stroke penalty; 3rd Offense- Player disqualification

The home/host school is responsible to report meet results to the local media

and television channels 7, 9, and 12 immediately following the contest. This is **GAME RESULTS:** mandatory for conference events and should be done for non-conference meets as well. Each home school is responsible to report meet results to their own

media.

TOURNAMENT DETAILS:

The conference golf Team and Individual Champion will be determined by all played conference legs. (5/08)

Individual scoring-Conference individual champions will be determined by total score of the seven (7) tournaments. Score 15 (10) places; Medalist- 15 (10) pts, 2nd- 14 (9)... 15th (10th)- 1. Points for ties will be averaged between the players involved, except 15th place where each will receive 1 pt. (12/21)

Team Points- Teams are awarded points based on how they finish each leg of the tournament (1st place- 7pts...7th place- 1pt.). Points for ties will be averaged between the teams involved.

Pairings for initial conference tournament will be determined by a lot conducted by the host school with the #5 players teeing off first, then #4 players ...

After completion of the initial tournament, the pairings will be based upon the scores, except that

no players from the same school/team will be paired together at any time, (amended 11/00)

The final leg host school may hold the awards ceremony.

PLAYER/COACH OF THE YEAR:

A Player and/or Coach of the Year award may be chosen by the coaches using any agreed upon criteria. The Player of the Year must be a 1st Team selection.

FINANCIAL
RESPONSIBILITY OF
WVC:

Awards- Team trophy, All-Conference medals- Gold (1st-5th), Silver- (6th-10th) and All-Conference Certificates (#1-10th plus #11-15 Honorable Mention).

All ties for individual medals or team awards will be broken using WIAA criteria. (12/12)
