

WISCONSIN VALLEY CONFERENCE TRACK BYLAWS

AD IN CHARGE:	DC Everest
ANNUAL MEETING DATE:	The annual meeting will take place at the DC Everest IMC on the 2nd Wednesday of September- 6:30pm. If there is a need to change this meeting, the AD in charge will notify all coaches and ADs.
PARTICIPATING TEAMS:	DC Everest, Marshfield, Merrill, Stevens Point, Wausau East, Wausau West, Wisconsin Rapids
SCHEDULE FORMAT:	The only recognized scheduled track and field meet is the conference outdoor. The Coed conference outdoor, run on the Tuesday before WIAA Regionals using regional format, will be rotated among the member schools. (12/08) In case of inclement weather necessitating a postponement, the meet will be held on the succeeding Thursday. The decision to postpone will be made by the host school's athletic administrator prior to the meet, or by the games committee after the schools have arrived at the meet site.
TIME(S)	Recommended start time is 3:30- all field events; 4:00pm- 4X800 relays; finals 30 minutes thereafter. (12/13)
SITES DETAILS:	If a member school lacks the facilities to conduct a meet of this caliber, arrangements to obtain the use of facilities of another school should be made. The listed school is responsible for all financial obligations for the meet unless other arrangements are worked out between the two schools involved.
UNIFORM/ EQUIPMENT:	NA
GAME RESULTS:	The home team is responsible to report or provide a link to the timing service contest results for local media and Channels 7, 9, and 12 immediately following the meet.
OFFICIALS:	The host school hires their own officials
ROSTERS:	NA
TOURNAMENT DETAILS:	<p>The National Federation order of running events is NOT followed in Wisconsin. The correct order of Events was designed by the Wisconsin high school track and field coaches. Note- Wheelchair event accommodations may be necessary.</p> <p>The maximum number of entries is 30 individual entries per school with a max of 3 entries per event. (12/12)</p> <p>Deadline for school entries is 7:00pm on the Monday prior to the conference outdoor meet. Blind changes may be made the day of the WVC Out/Indoor meet before receiving meet program but an athlete may not be moved from one event to another. Failure to comply with this rule will result in entries receiving no preference for seeding. There will be no re-seeding. (12/09)</p> <p>Only athletes of competing schools and meet personnel are allowed in the infield during the meet. This rule may be modified or changed to meet the host school's facilities.</p> <p>The shots and discus used in competition will be certified by the host school. (12/09)</p> <p>The order of events will be the same as for the W.I.A.A. Sectional competition including a 30-minute break following the 3200 relay. (12/12)</p> <p>The meet manager shall fill all lanes (up to 9) for finals in each event. (12/08)</p> <p>The games committee is to consider wind direction and velocity in determining the direction of the approach for the pole vault., long, high, and triple jumps. This is to be done for safety reasons. (12/08)</p> <p>Games committee composition will be meet mgr, starter & referee, head boys coach of next year's host school and head girls coach from previous year's host. (12/12)</p>
CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP:	Team - W.V.C. Team Trophy to the Conference Meet winning team.
ALL CONFERENCE SELECTION	Individuals in individual and relay events - 1st place - gold medal and W.V.C. certificate 2nd place - silver medal and W.V.C. certificate 3rd place - W.V.C. certificate
PLAYER/COACH OF THE YEAR:	A Player and/or Coach of the Year award may be chosen by the coaches using any agreed upon criteria. The Player of the Year must be a 1st Team selection.
FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY OF WVC:	The WVC will pay for a third-party Timing Service if needed by the host school. Provided Awards include- Team trophy, All-Conference medals (1st and 2nd Team) and All-Conference Certificates (1st/2nd team plus 3rd Place Honorable Mention).
OTHER MEETS FOR WVC TEAMS:	There are other meets conducted for WVC Teams, that are not financed (awards or timing system rental) by the conference. The costs for these meets will be shared by participating schools.
PERTINENT INFO:	W.I.A.A. rules and regulations will govern competition. (See W.I.A.A. Handbook)
