## WISCONSIN VALLEY CONFERENCE BOYS BASKETBALL BYLAWS

Marshfield; Asst- Stevens Point AD IN CHARGE:

**ANNUAL MEETING** 

DATE:

The annual meeting will take place at the DC Everest IMC on the Monday prior to the start of Regionals- 6:30pm (Week #35). If there is a need

to change this meeting, the AD in charge will notify all coaches and ADs.

PARTICIPATING TEAMS: DC Everest, Marshfield, Merrill, Stevens Point, Wausau East, Wausau West, Wisconsin Rapids

SCHEDULE FORMAT:

A double-round robin conference schedule will be played as scheduled. (12/11)

The JV schedules will be the same as the varsity schedule with the exception of B/G double-header games.

When games need to be re-scheduled because of weather related issues, schools should: (12/08)

a. Flip-flop Home & Away sites if weather is acceptable at the Away location.

b. Contests should be made up on the next available date. Note- 'next available date' means the first date when no conflicting school events i.e.

concerts, awards program, other WVC games in that sport... are scheduled.

TIME(S)

Wisconsin Valley Conference basketball games will begin at 7:15 p.m. (5/17) Saturday games maybe played in the afternoon by mutual agreement of the schools. Double-header games involving both the Boys and Girls playing at the same site will begin at 6:00pm and ~7:45pm.

All JV games will begin at 5:45 p.m. or as determined by host school facilities. JV games will be played to completion with 16 minute halves and

a 10 minute halftime.

Warm ups will begin 20 minutes prior to the scheduled varsity start time.

SITES DETAILS:

The first row of bleachers behind the varsity team shall be reserved for the JV squad in gyms where the varsity squad occupies the first row of

bleachers. The same opportunity shall be provided for the sophomore squad.

For Safety, Sportsmanship and Administrative purposes students will not be allowed to sit behind or under the game baskets at WVC girls and boys basketball games. Member schools with bleachers or spectator seating behind or under the game baskets will be made available for pep

bands, and/or adult spectators only. (5/13/99)

UNIFORM/ EQUIPMENT: White jerseys will be worn at home.

The home team shall; a) contact local paper and area TV media (7, 9, 12) immediately following the game b), send all game results to the GAME RESULTS:

conference statistician. \*Note it is required that the coaches or team statisticians go over the scorebook following the game. The home team's

scorebook will be the official scorebook and will be used for the conference statistics.

OFFICIALS: The conference commissioner contracts the umpires and notifies the schools of the officiating assignments for the approved schedule as of the

prior year April 15.

**ROSTERS:** Each coach/school is to send out a team roster to all W.V.C. schools or post their current roster in rSchool.

This team roster is used for the program and should include the names of the players in numerical order, position, height, and year in school.

This roster should include he names of the coaches, managers, district administrator, principal, athletic director and cheerleaders.

TOURNAMENT DETAILS: NA

CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP: Each school to be eligible for championship consideration must play the schedule as adopted. Conference Champions shall be determined by the

final WVC win-loss record.

ALL CONFERENCE **SELECTION** 

All-conference basketball teams will be chosen annually:

Nominations for ALL (except VFA football) sports are due one week prior to the respective coaches meeting. The commissioner will then send

out a composite ballot containing all nominees.

At the meeting each coach will discuss their own nominees; may delete but not add players.

Coaches will fill out a ballot after all discussions are complete.

Coaches rank nominees 12->1 with 12 being the best player in the WVC

The AD or group facilitator will read aloud each school's 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> team selections openly.

Top 5 point getters are 1<sup>st</sup> Team; next 5 are 2<sup>nd</sup> Team.

No ties- tiebreaker is the highest vote given by any coach; still tied-next highest vote...

The 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> highest vote getters are Honorable Mention.

Any nominee receiving any votes that is not on 1st team or 2nd team, shall be awarded Honorable Mention. If a school did not receive any all-

conference selections they may select an HM player from their list of nominees. (8/23)

Any individual conference award is subject to the school's discretion.

After all other voting has been completed, coaches may nominate then choose a Most Valuable Defensive Player

of the Year for the conference. This player will receive a WVC certificate only. (5/24)

YEAR:

PLAYER/COACH OF THE A Player and/or Coach of the Year award may be chosen by the coaches using any agreed upon criteria. The Player of the Year must be a 1st

Team selection.

FINANCIAL **RESPONSIBILITY OF** WVC:

Awards- Team trophy (ies), All-Conference medals (1st and 2nd Team) and All-Conference Certificates (1st/2nd team plus Honorable Mention).
